Sub: Industrial Action Notice to protest against inordinate delay for acceptance of demand of Wage Revision and Pension Revision of MTNL Employees, irregularity in disbursement of monthly salary and denial of regular JNC meeting to majority unions.

### Respected Sir,

The **FORUM OF MTNL UNIONS AND ASSOCIATIONS** representing the Executives and Non-Executives working in MTNL Delhi & Mumbai would like to submit the following few facts for favour of your kind consideration: -

- Whereas existing wage structure and its various provisions were in operation till 31/12/2016.
- Whereas recommendations submitted by the 3<sup>rd</sup> Pay revision committee Constituted for Pay revision of Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) have been approved by the Government of India.
- Whereas the policy directives have been issued by DPE vide letter No- W-02/ 0028/2017-DPE (WC)-GL-XIII/17 Dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2017, for Pay Revision of Board level and below Board Level Executives and Non-Unionized Supervisors of Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) w.e.f. 01/01/2017.
- Whereas the decision of the Government regarding wage policy for the 8<sup>th</sup> round of wage negotiations for workmen in Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) has been conveyed by DPE vide letter No. W-02/0015/2016-DPE (WC)-GL-XXIV/17 Dated 24<sup>th</sup> November 2017.
- That MTNL Management had assured in the JNC meeting held on 28/03/2018 that the case for implementation of 3<sup>rd</sup> PRC/Wage Revision in MTNL will be taken up with DOT and issue shall be resolved shortly. Further it has been also assured that, MTNL Management will request to DoT that 'Affordability Clause' shall not be applied in case of MTNL being unique since it has a legacy in which erstwhile Govt. servants have taken absorption at the time of corporatization of Govt. Department. But till date status of this matter not yet informed by MTNL Management.
- That non-absorbed ITS Officers and many other Government employees working in MTNL are given all the benefits of the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC and other allowances with perks as revised by the Government of India from time to time while the same benefits are withheld for the absorbed employees of MTNL.

• That CMD had assured to create the fund for pension to MTNL employees as per 2<sup>nd</sup> PRC and DPE OM in the financial year 2021-2022. And regarding wage revision as per 3<sup>rd</sup> PRC, it was assured that a wage negotiation committee for non-executives will be constituted after taking approval from DOT shortly. Minutes of the meeting with CMD and Dir (HR) were issued vide letter No-MTNL/CO/IRW/21(135)/2017-18 dated-21-12-2021.

Considering no breakthrough so far, FORUM OF MTNL UNIONS AND ASSOCIATIONS has decided to hold Agitation/Protest action for immediate action on the following long pending demands.

- 1. Ensure payment of salary on the last day of every month
- 2. Implementation of 3<sup>rd</sup> PRC / Wage revision
- 3. Revision of Pension of Retired MTNL Employees
- 4. 30% Corpus for terminal benefits
- 5. Counting of casual service for pension
- 6. To conduct regular JNC Meeting with majority unions
- 7. Implementation of 5% IDA Merger of retired employees
- 8. Merger of MTNL & BSNL
