Subject: Shortage of essential store items and arrangement of funds for maintenance of services.

Sir,

In reference of our previous letter No. MEA/Delhi Circle/2015-16 dated 23-12-2015, in which we have raise some points about shortage of essential store items and arrangement of funds for maintenance of services but till date no progress have been reported from all over Delhi. The maintenance of services has become an uphill task due to shortage of essential store items and other resources viz. TSF Kits (1,2,3,4), Cables (50, 100, 200 & 400 paired), Jumper Wire, Twisted (Drop) Wire, Telephone Instruments, Modems, Vehicles, OF Cables, OF Systems, Optical Power Meter, OTDR, Joint Enclosure, Tuffiex, GDMS. In addition to this, there is no Contract existing for maintenance and Project for PIJF woks, due to which staff is unable to carry out cable maintenance effectively and even for new network especially in heavy demand area.

The OF Cable laying Contract has also exhausted both for quantity and time period. So, transmission unit is facing hardship and difficulties in maintaining existing OFC network. There is urgent need to finalise the tender (in process) earliest.

Since, MEA and its members are fully committed and endeavoured for improvement of quality of Services, to increase customer base and to increase the revenue of Delhi unit but for inter-alia above stated difficulties, we are unable to do. This is building frustration and demoralisation among the employees.

We hope that your good-self will take prompt action to resolve shortage of all essential store items and other resources to help improve the services, increase customer base and to increase the revenue of Delhi Unit. This will also help lower the growing frustration and demoralisation among the employees. If no concrete action is taken within fifteen days to resolve above issues, we will be constrained to take appropriate trade union measures as deemed fit in the interest of the company.
