Sub: Filling up of three vacant posts of Executive Engineer (Elect.) on SCF basis against already held DPC in

December 2015.

Respected Sir,

There are total 10 Nos. of posts of Executive Engineer (Elect) in Delhi & Mumbai to look after the huge infrastructure of MTNL. Out of these 10 posts only 5 post are to be filled up on seniority cum fitness basis as other five Nos. have been kept reserved for direct recruitment. In the said DPC only 3 Executives were promoted. Further another three EE(E)s have retired in November & December 2015 due to which another 3 vacancies are further created. Now these vacancies can be filled up Immediately and against the same DPC if it is considered by the competent authority. As another DPC will take at least another six months and as on date only 20% posts are being filled up, it is requested that these three vacancies created by the retirement may also please be got filled so that at least 50% of the total sanctioned strength becomes available to work for the department. This will certainly boost high morale and will create positive motivation in the Executives who are eagerly waiting to get their promotion.

It is to further highlight that it will not create any financial burden to the department also, as the affected executives are already drawing E-5 & E-6 pay scales and have rendered more than 28 years of service individually.

This office is hopeful that the above request being justified will be considered on priority and the request of the affected Executives shall be well accepted by your good self. For your early consideration please.
