Sub: **Protest notice against non-payment of salary and other critical issues in MTNL**

Madam/ Sir,

While appreciating and acknowledging the efforts being made by the Govt to get MTNL/BSNL revived, we are also constrained to mention that the employees, who have sweat their blood in building the very base and infrastructure of MTNL and also putting all out efforts to maintain the services in spite of acute scarcity of resources available to their disposal, are being totally ignored, marginalized and put into unbearable sufferings for no fault in this whole revival process. Delay in crucial decisions have further worsened and compounded the day to day functioning and now the very survival of the company.

Presently, situation has deteriorated to such an extent that salary of June month has not been paid till date, while July month is also ending. Families of 22,000 employees have been left out and deserted to suffer unbearable miseries. They are living in distress, anxiety and psychic trauma.

Notwithstanding the above, employees' welfare issues have not been duly considered while proposing the revival plan of MTNL. On the contrary, revival proposals are being made putting aside employees issues and interests, thereby causing employees to suffer in perpetuity for no fault of theirs.

Keeping in view the above, we are constraint to serve this protest/and agitation notice to press following alarming issues concerning employees interest and revival of MTNL:

1. Payment of June and July 2019 salary by 31 July 2019 and ensure regular payment of salary on due date of every month
2. Implementation of 3rd PRC/wage revision
3. Pension Revision for retired MTNL employees as per 7th CPC.
4. Counting of casual service period for pensionary benefits
5. Consider (our already conveyed) proposals of MTNL revival immediately
